

TIDE TIMES + MOON PHASES

Note:

- The First Quarter Moon Phase, which means there will be little moon light to guide you.
- The tidal phase will be close to spring tides (the highest of the high tides and lowest of the low tides).
- Tidal routes can become cut off close to high tide times quicker than you might think. Check and double check.
- Be prepared, be aware of your times and distances.
- Use the alternative high tidal routes if unsure.
