



TIDE TIMES + SUN TIMES + MOON PHASES

Notes:

- New Moon.
- The tidal phase will be close to <u>spring tides</u> (the <u>highest of the high tides</u> and lowest of the low tides).
- Tidal routes can be cut off close to high tide times <u>quicker</u> than you might think. <u>Check</u> and <u>double check</u>.
- Be prepared, be aware of your pacing, times and distances.
- Use the <u>alternative high tide</u> routes if unsure.
